COUNTY OFFICIAL PLAN AMENDMENT (OPA) PROCESS

Pre-consultation



- Provide the applicant an opportunity to discuss their proposal, inform them of next steps and all required documents to be submitted the Planning and Development Department.
- Refer to County By-law 2019-10



Council must make a decision within 120 days of the applicant being notified that the application has been deemed complete.

Application Submission

- County must notify applicants within 30 days of receiving a complete application, otherwise they can appeal the Ontario Land Tribunal
- Notify the public after application is deemed complete or provide an explanatory letter to the applicant if the submission is incomplete

Processing Complete Application

- Notification of amendment to identified agencies and persons within 15 days of а notice completeness having been issued
- Made available to the public within those 15 days



Council Meeting

- Notify applicant and public of the Council Meeting and all specific meeting details.
- Hold meeting and receive direction from Council (a preliminary report will be presented to Council for their review).

Informal Public Meeting

 Council may deem it necessary to public undertake additional consultation as a result of the Council meeting.

Comments and Report

- Preliminary comments will be issued to the applicant and receive the applicant's response
- A recommendation report will be prepared by the County Planning and Development division



Statutory Public Meeting and Council Decision

- Notice of Public Meeting must be given at least 20 days prior to the date of the meeting.
- Final recommendation report for the proposed OPA will Council. presented to
- This meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to make representations with respect to the proposed amendment.

Approval from Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (MMAH)

- All County OPAs are subject to approval by
- Forward to the Ministry within 15 days after the adopted by Council
- Once MMAH has issued a decision a wirtten notice will be provided

Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT)

- Decisions may be appealed to the OLT within 20 days from the date that MMAH issue the notice of decision

OPA Implementation

 The amendment or part of the amendment that was adopted that is not subject of an appeal, comes into effect as an OPA or part of the OPA on the day after the last day for filling a notice of appeal
