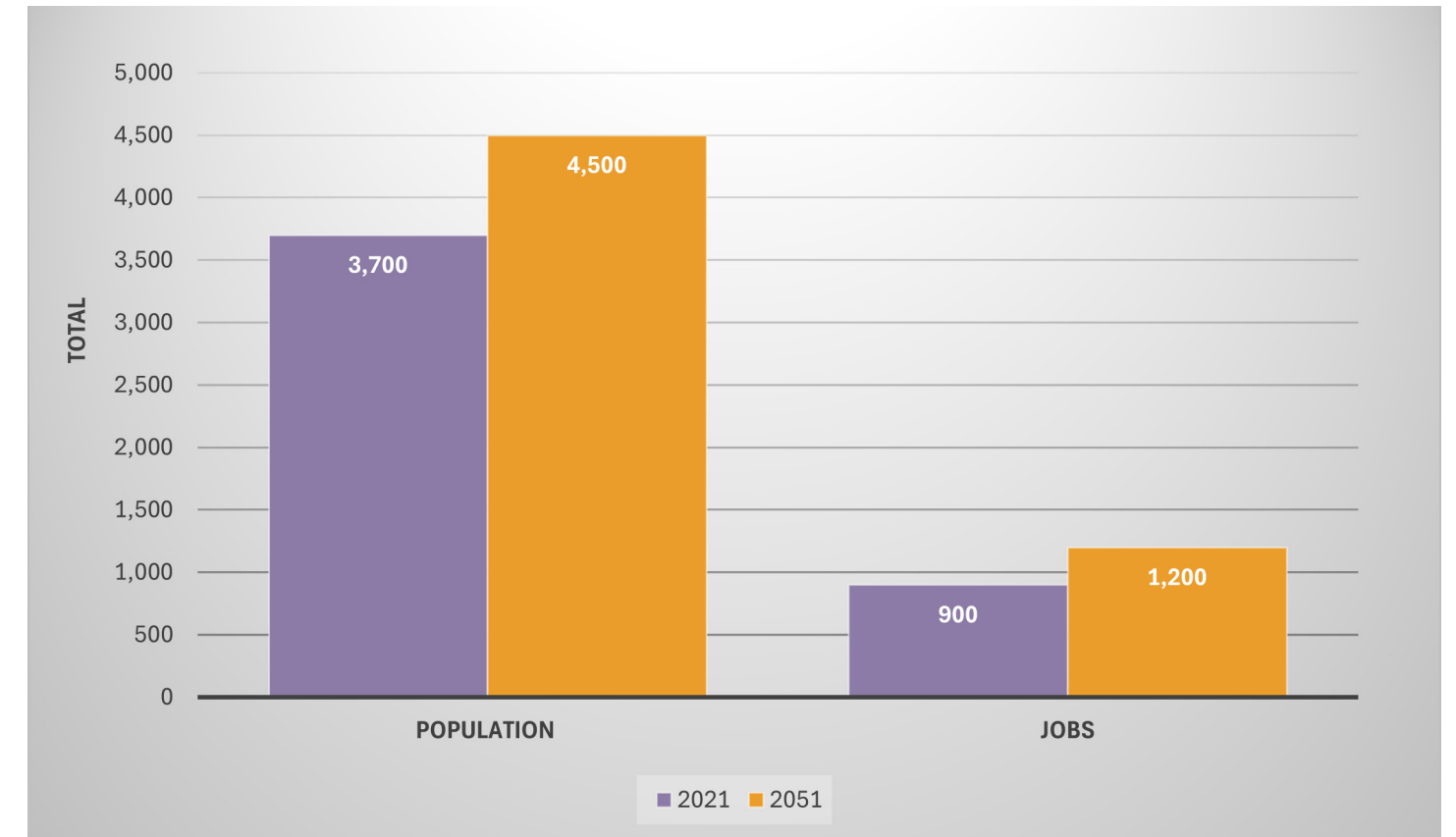

LAND NEEDS PROJECTIONS

The Council adopted County Official Plan provides land need projections for the Township of Mulmur. To achieve an appropriate mix of land uses, the County asserts that Mulmur should seek to accommodate 1.5 net hectares (1.9 gross hectares) of Community Employment (Commercial, Institutional, or Mixed-Use) land by 2051. There are no residential intensification targets or greenfield residential land need projections for the Township of Mulmur.
