Occupancy Requirements

The building envelope is substantially completed: cladding, roofing, windows, doors, assemblies requiring a fire resistance rating, closures, insulation, vapour
barriers and air barriers.
The structure is substantially completed and ready to be used for its intended purpose.
Insulation and vapour barrier is protected from mechanical damage where required.
Required electrical supply is provided.
Required fire fighting access routes have been provided and are accessible.
Required exits, floor access and egress systems, handrails, guards, smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, fire separations and fire stopping components and systems are completed and operational.
Required exhaust fume barriers and self-closing devices on doors between
attached or built in garage and the dwelling unit are completed and operational.
Foamed plastics are protected by an approved covering.
The water system, building drain, building sewer, drainage system and venting system are completed, operational and tested (final plumbing test required).
Required plumbing fixtures are substantially completed and operational.

A house shall not be occupied without approved occupancy.

All items above must be satisfied.
