Subject: **Draft Operating Plan – Summary of Public Comment**

Purpose

To provide information about the public input to the draft County Forest operating plan, as of September 11, 2020. The public comment period will end on September 30, 2020.

Background

Public comment on the draft operating plan was solicited through Mailchimp, Join in Dufferin, ads in local newspapers, information on the County website, and direct e-mail to local municipalities and other stakeholders.

The majority of the input has come through the surveys that were part of the Join in Dufferin project.

Summary of Survey Results

A total of 204 people have completed the survey. It is important to note that the only mandatory question was the first one, asking whether or not the respondent was a user of the forest. Consequently, not all of the questions were answered by all of the respondents.

A detailed summary of the surveys is attached to this report and some highlights are provided below:

1. The majority of the respondents (96.6%) are users of the Forest.
2. The most commonly mentioned activities (in order from the highest) were mountain biking/fat biking (non-motorized), horseback riding, and hiking. Respondents were able to choose up to three activities. Interestingly, a small

number indicated that they use the Forest for dirt biking/ATVing even though that is not permitted.

3. The Main Tract was by far used the most, followed by the Mono Tract and the Hockley Tract. Respondents were able to choose up to three tracts.
4. When asked about infrastructure improvements, the top three responses were wayfinding signs (which already exist at the Main Tract), portable toilets, and pictographic signs describing permitted uses. For this question, respondents could choose any number of answers.
5. When non-users were asked why they didn't use the Forest, the majority chose the "other" option but did not specify a reason. The choices were: didn't know about it, didn't know it was accessible to the public, and not interested in outdoor recreation.
6. The most important values of the County Forest were availability for recreation, closely followed by wildlife habitat, and existence features. Income generation for the County was rated as "somewhat important" by the majority of respondents.
7. The majority (73.6%) of respondents felt that the ads and signs about hunting seasons have been effective in informing users.
8. When asked why or why not they thought the signs and ads were effective, the responses varied widely. Some of the suggested improvements included:
 - a) distributing the information more broadly, including through more signs, more ads, radio ads, and social media;
 - b) that hunters need to be more informed that there are other recreational users;
 - c) other activities should be banned during hunting; and
 - d) hunting should not be permitted where there are trails
9. The majority (80.5%) of respondents felt that the County is doing a good job in general of informing people about what is happening with the County Forest.
10. When asked why or why not they thought the County was doing a good job of distributing information, the responses varied widely. Some of the suggested improvements included:
 - a) some variation of modernizing information delivery – more e-mails, more advertising of the mailing list, social media, sending e-mails to all County residents;
 - b) more traditional information delivery – newspapers, notices at the Forest, pamphlets at local stores
 - c) advertising in areas outside Dufferin County;
 - d) better communication/information dissemination to the equine community; and
 - e) insufficient consultation with the public regarding rule/by-law changes, especially with regard to the trail separation in the Main Tract

11. Suggestions for low-cost revenue sources included:

- a) collecting donations through a donation “box” and/or online accessed with a QR code;
- b) having some form of membership fee/paid parking/seasonal pass/user fee;
- c) nature walks/tours for school groups and other interested groups;
- d) donations toward memorial benches/named trails;
- e) selling “branded” gear;
- f) charging for permits for motorized vehicle use and camping; and
- g) increasing event fees

12. General comments on the operating plan included:

- a) past performance should be considered in awarding logging contracts;
- b) eliminating hunting where recreational use is high;
- c) more signs marking trails;
- d) more trails;
- e) access for motorized vehicles;
- f) no access for motorized vehicles;
- g) horse trailer parking at the Randwick Tract; and
- h) more property acquisition/increasing greenspace

Other Input

In addition, three emails have been received asking that the County permit the use of motorized vehicles (dirt bikes and/or ATVs) in the Forest. A change.org petition in support of this action was also submitted with one of the emails. The petition had 1608 signatures, 150 of which (10%) were identifiably from Dufferin County. A number of the signers identified themselves only as being from “Canada”, making it impossible to know if they were from Dufferin County or not. Those identified as “Shelburne, Canada” were assumed to be from Dufferin County, regardless of the fact that there is also Shelburne, Nova Scotia. Many of the signers were from outside the province and even outside the country. The petition, as well as the emails received, are attached to this report.

Two emails of a more general nature were also received, and are attached to this report.

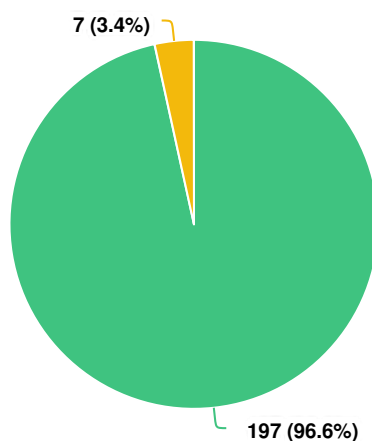

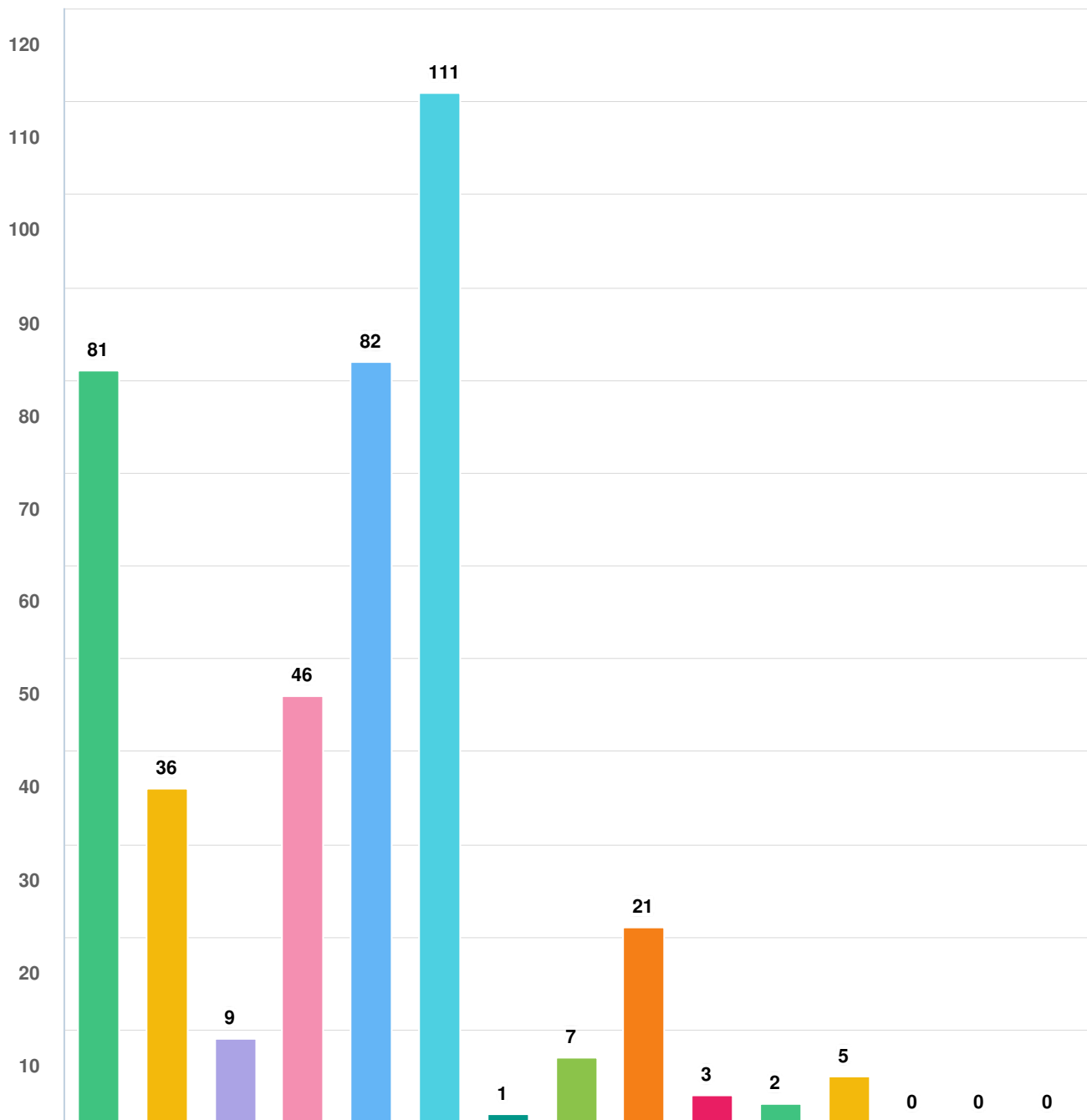

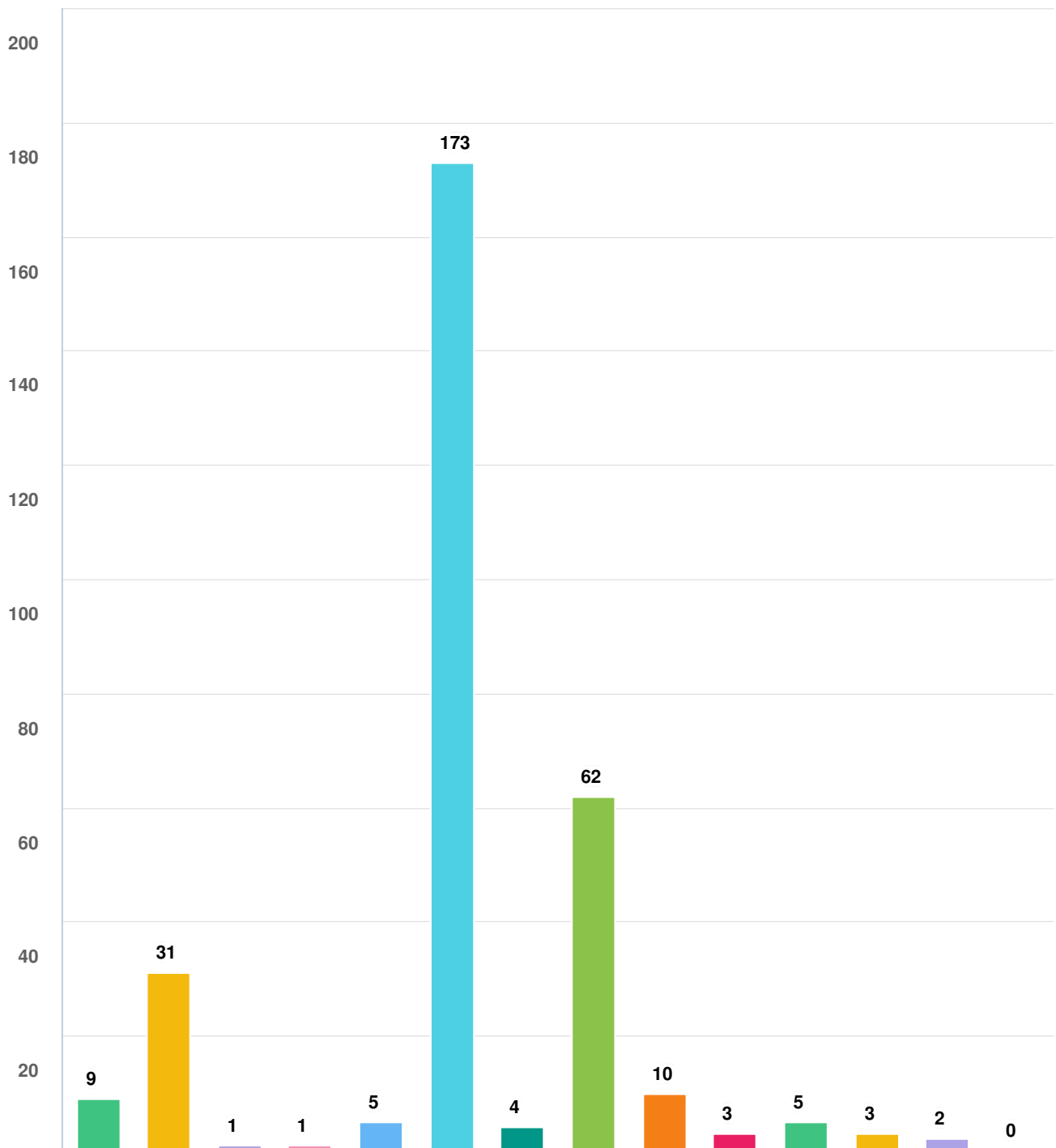

Q3 Which tracts do you use the most (choose up to three)?



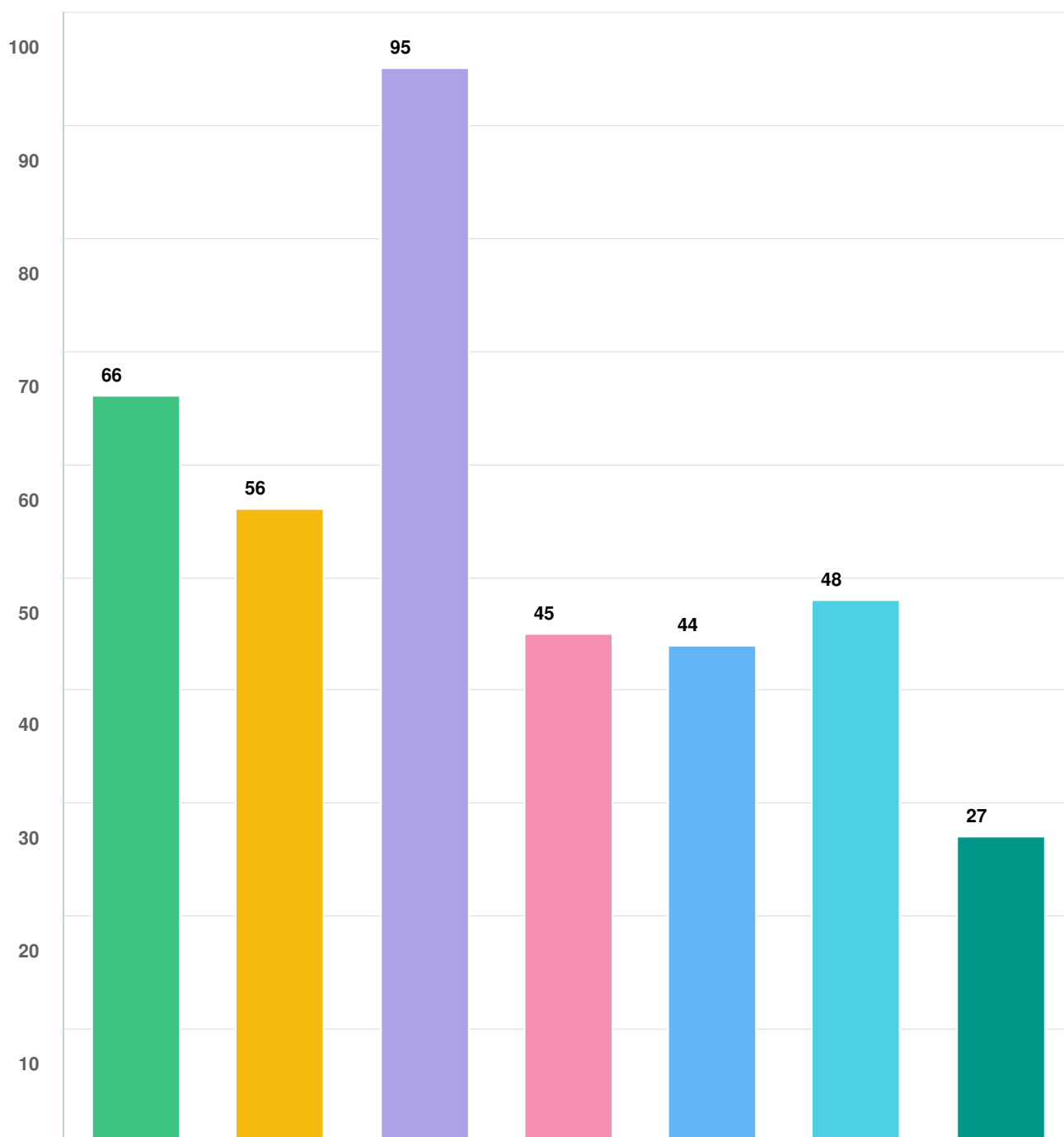

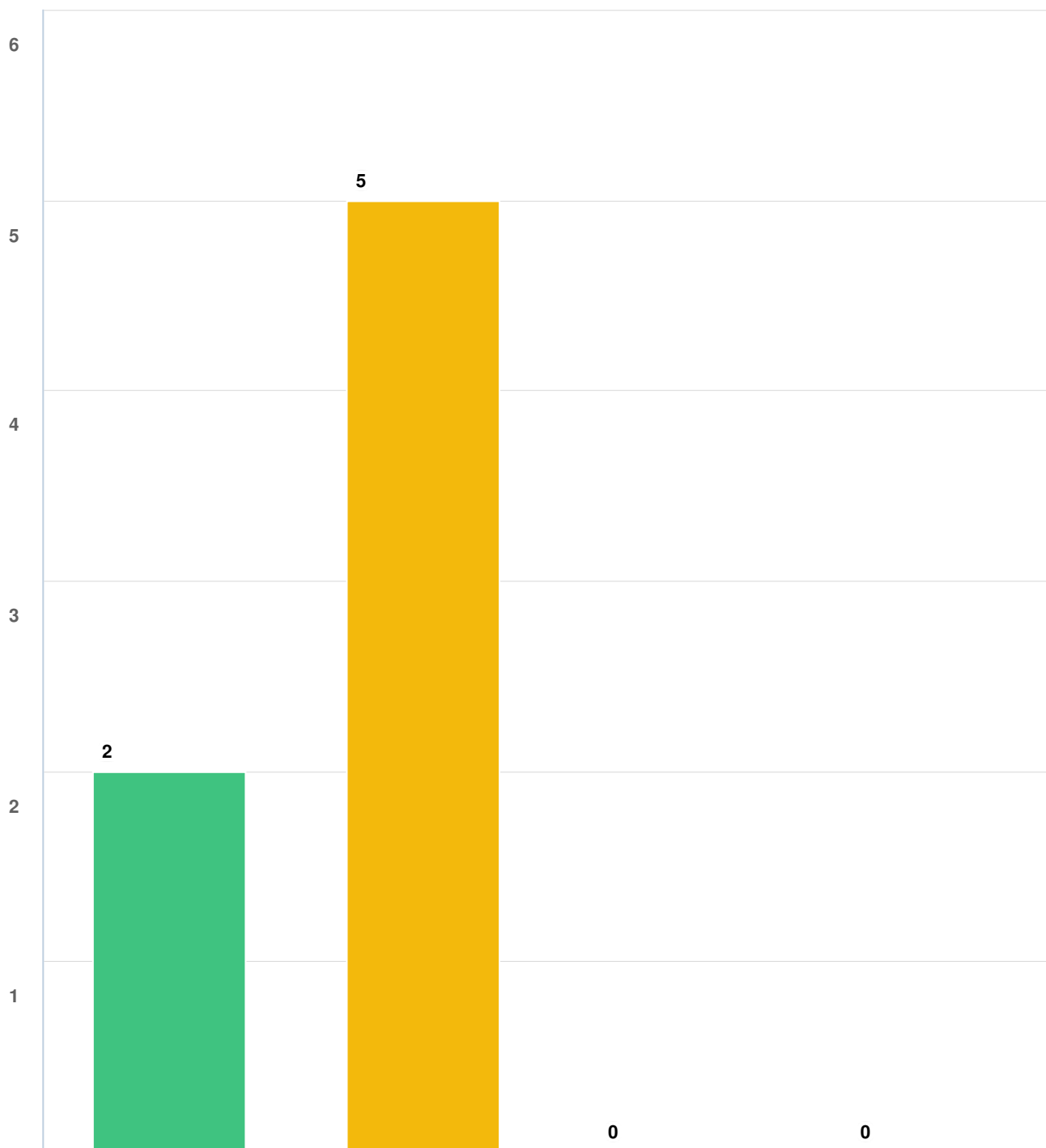

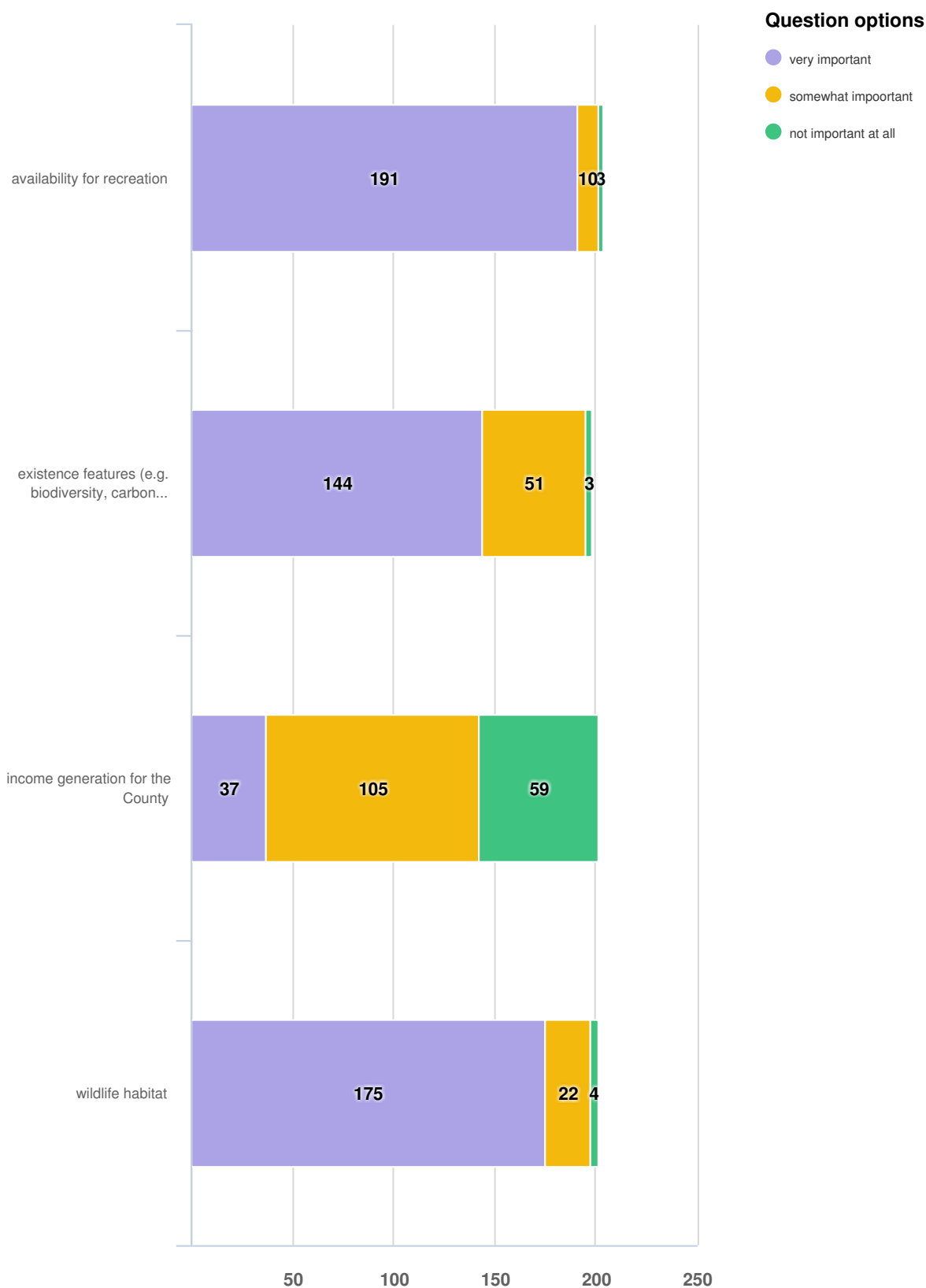

Q6 How important are the following County Forest values to you?

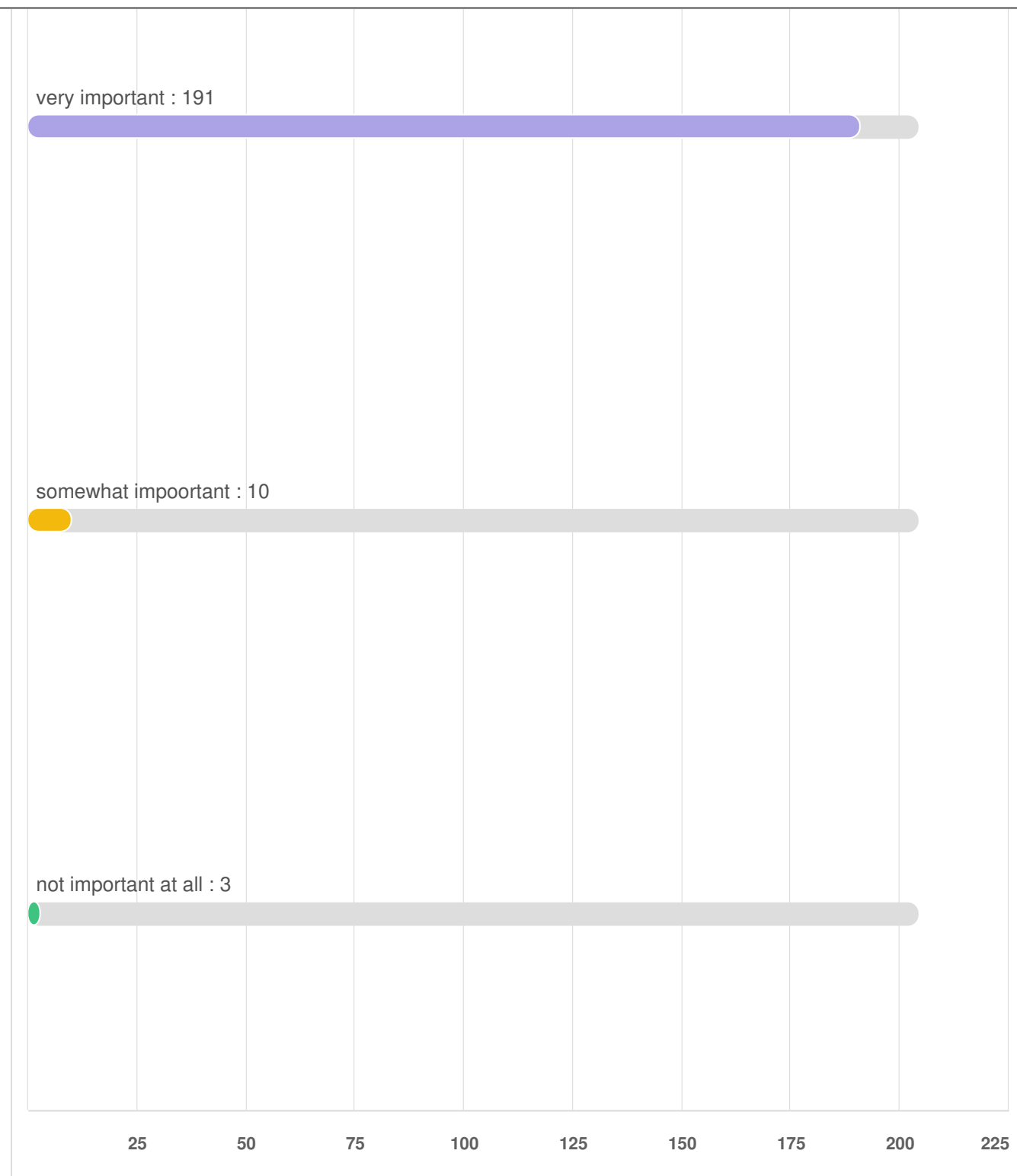

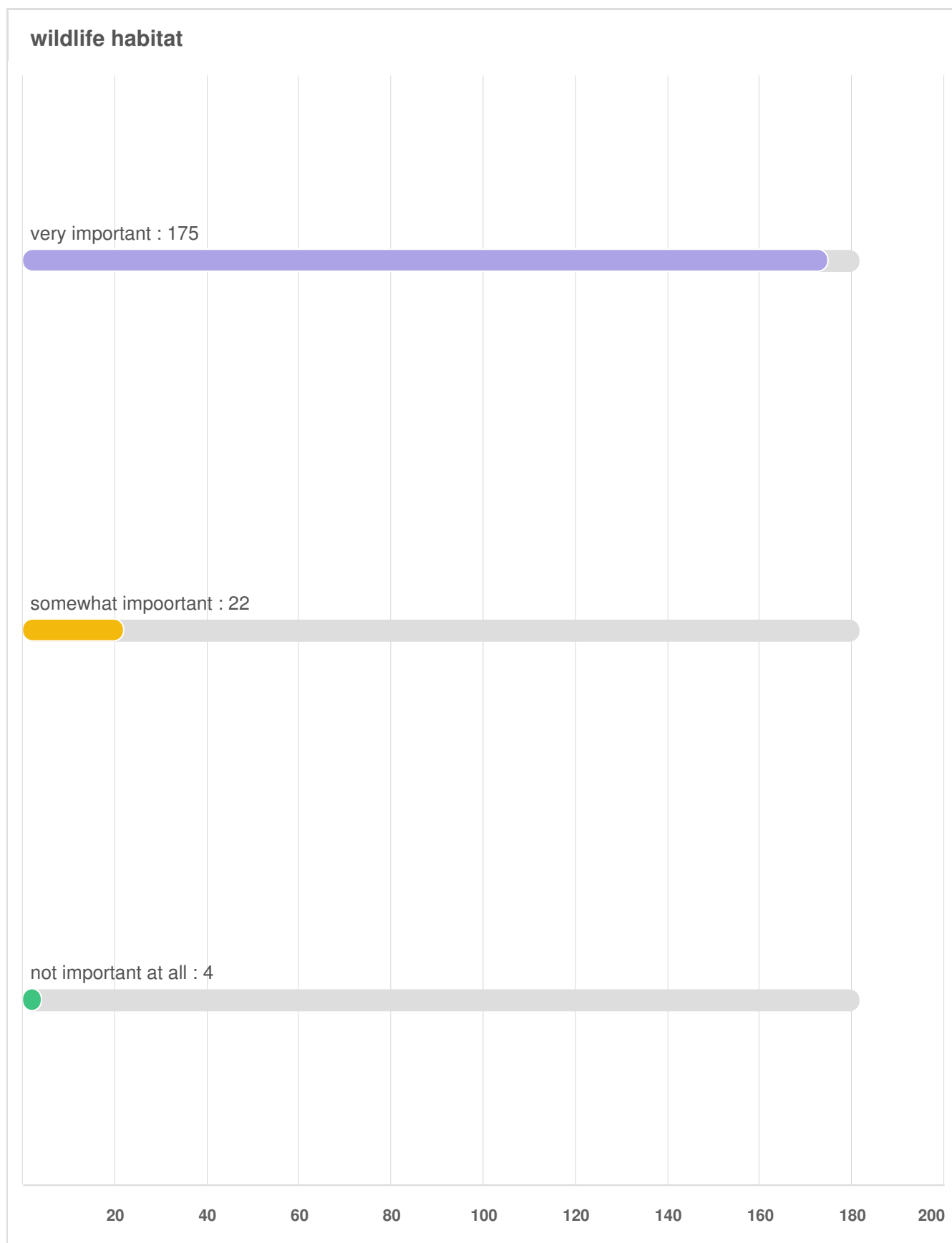

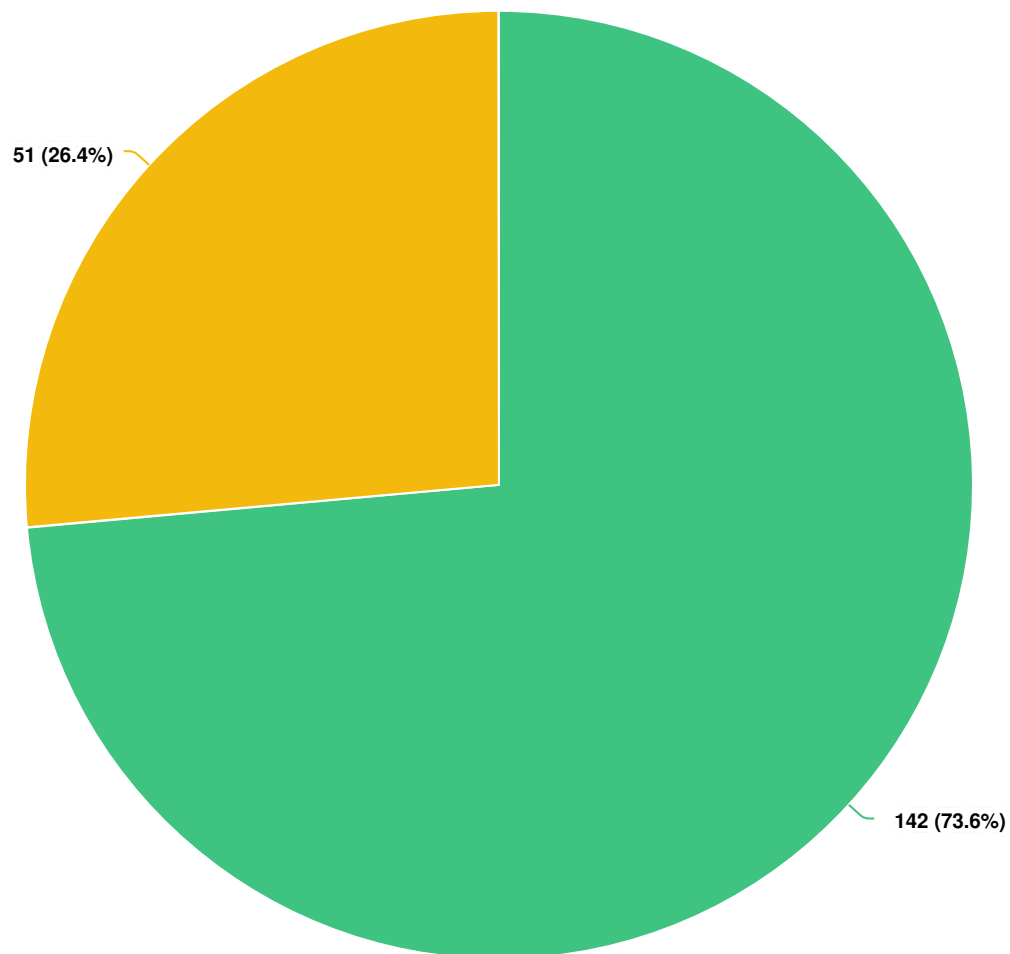

In addition to properties with significant woodlands, significant wetlands should also be considered for acquisition -- for instance, the wetland at the intersection of the 15th Sideroad and the 4th Line, which is a wonderful habitat for numerous species of amphibians and birds. Finally, in terms of economic and social sustainability, it should be considered that the forest network in the County plays an important "infrastructure" role, for instance in watershed and erosion management, carbon sequestration, and pollution reduction. This should be taken into account. The forests also improve the mental/emotional, and likely physical, health of users, as mentioned in the plan. However, it also benefits those who may not use the forests directly; many residents of this County choose to live here specifically because of its rural/natural character and forests/greenspace, and this has tourism appeal as well. Increasing the amount of protected forests and wetlands in the County would be beneficial in all these regards.

Dear Warden White and Caroline Mach,

I am a representative of the Dufferin Rooftop Recreation Riders Association (DRRRA), we are a non-profit club and part of the Ontario Federation of Trail Riders. It has been brought to our attention that the County is developing a new five-year forest plan. Our organization is hoping to gain access to the Dufferin County Forests. For years the dirt biking community has been excluded from using the Dufferin County Forests and we are optimistic you can change this.

We recently launched a petition and have collected over 1600 signatures in support of access to Dufferin County Forests. In Dufferin County there is no legal public place for residents to ride dirt bikes, which means they are travelling to Simcoe County to ride in the Simcoe County Forests. This means that Dufferin County residents are taking their wallets into Simcoe county and spending money there instead of spending it in Dufferin County.

Simcoe County allows all user groups to access their forests, from hikers and horseback riders, mountain bikers to ATV's and dirt bikes. There is enough forest for everyone to share. Many of the Ontario Trail Riders associations, including the Simcoe County Recreational Riders Association, also do spring trail clean up and maintenance including the removal of dumped garbage. This is something our organization would also be happy to perform in Dufferin County Forests.

In Dufferin County the main argument against dirt bikes seems to concern noise levels. This seems unfair as Snowmobiles have access to the forests in the winter with few complaints and they are typically louder than dirt bikes. The average dirt bike is 96 decibels which is quieter than the average gas-powered leaf blower. Many manufacturers have started making e-bikes which makes them virtually silent. The Ontario Federation of Trail Riders have a very strict policy on the noise level for dirt bikes and mandate that all riders are plated (Green or Blue plated) and insured. Only valid members are permitted to access the forests and trained trail stewards supervise forests for non-compliance and conduct enforcement checks with the local police.

On Protection and Maintenance of the Dufferin Forest Trails

To whom it may concern at the Mulmur Township,

This letter is addressing several concerns about the preservation of the forest and safety of its visitors. As the forest is in possession of the Dufferin County, it is your committee's responsibility to tend to the well-being and the flourishing of the forest for future generations. At present, the forest trails are becoming increasingly hazardous as a result of human activity. In specific, there has been an increase in damage due to excessive equestrian usage and dried logs being stood upright against trees presenting a serious fire hazard. In fact, the geological era there we're living in, known as the Anthropocene, has been defined by the impact of human activity on its environment.

Firstly, equestrians need only a single point of entry into the forest such as Main Lot on Airport Rd. Presently, riders gain access on whichever path they please and are allowed to traverse an excessive number of trails. Hooves degrade the structural integrity of the paths until unsuitable for both the four-legged and the two as the surface is far more violently impacted than the soft rubber of bicycle tires or running shoes. The intact edges of the paths and surrounding greenery are then threatened as equestrians are forced to utilize the dwindling slivers of safe footing supported by the matrix of living roots. Compact mossy trails surrounded by lush flora degrade into strips of uneven, barren dirt that encroaches beyond the carefully planned path boundaries year by year. This issue is greatly accelerated due to allowance of dangerous, high-speed galloping on the same paths used by non-riders. As the horses rush through the forest, cyclists or dogs that cross their path startle all those involved. Oftentimes, riders impose on other pedestrians by demanding we speak to their horse, consoling it as it passes. When proactively moving off the trail to let incoming riders pass out of practicality and good faith, the non-equestrians are then reprimanded for hiding behind a tree and spooking the equines and their riders. In addition, there are already reported problems of hikers damaging the MCL of the knee from treading progressively degraded trails. This is a recipe for an avoidable collision in the future. Horse faeces are also left on the centre of the paths for well over a year at a time to the inconvenience of all.

Secondly, care should be taken to make sure all wood debris in the forest is always in as much contact with the ground as possible. This is simply taking an extra few minutes with a chainsaw during regular forest maintenance to make sure all wood pieces are flat to the earth and not propped up where they would become dry due to exposure to the air.

Otherwise, the dry debris will:

- 1- Become a fire hazard that threatens the entire forest
- 2- Lock up valuable nutrients that could otherwise have been cycled back into the forest and contribute to its resilience and biodiversity

Once the debris is properly integrated with the floor, it will be processed far quicker by nature and quickly become part of a healthy soil that's able to retain moisture. The forest floor will become less vulnerable to erosion and fires.

Keeping the safety of the paths in mind, debris on the paths need to be regularly moved just off to the sides and placed in good contact with the soil. Here, decomposition will get a head start where it is needed the most without impeding recreational use. This will also reduce the likelihood of man-made accidental fires as the trails would be the most likely place for this to occur.

Global warming will only speed moisture loss and further exacerbate the problems stated above as time goes by. Future generations will pay the price for our negligence should we fail to act right away and enact these relatively simple measures.
