CALL TO ORDER

The Committee confirmed the guidelines that were developed at the last meeting.

Foundational Pieces

Committee members discussed foundational pieces, what is meaningful to this work and what's on the radar. Generally, there is concensus that making real change can be achieved by tackling issues in manageable pieces. Reflecting the needs of the community is important and focusing supporting on racialized peoples is on the radar now. There is an acknowledgement that ongoing gtraining and education is important.

Working Groups

The focus of the Working Groups is to improve access and eliminate barriers to County Services. This is part of the County Council approved madate. The committee discussed how to effectively get things done and agreed on two working groups:

Group A - Economic Development – Steve, Sabina, Althea, Alethia, Preeya

Group B - Human Services - Laura, Jordan, Angela, Christie

Others to be contacted in advance of next meeting to determine which group they wish to participate in.

Members will work with County staff to understand what and how services are currently offered, gather information from the community and then work to make recommendations that will help improve access and eliminate barriers.

Meetings for each group will be organized in the coming weeks.

Scholarship Program Dicussion

The committee discussed the scholarship program and the inclusion of two additional scholarships starting 2021. One is to be designated for a person of colour and another for an indigenous student. The purpose of adding the 2 new scholarships is to ensure there is equitable access for marginalized groups to apply and that it is equitablyawarded. There was concensus that the language in the application could be updated to be more inclusive and to better speak to the intended audience.
