Discussion

- 1. Chair Trisha Linton proposed the subcommittee first define the opportunities & expectations of the subcommittee; to understand the functions and work of the Economic Development & Tourism teams, and determine tangible steps that can be taken together
- 2. Economic Development Officer Karisa Downey & Tourism Manager Terrilyn Kunopaski offered brief overviews of their current work and priorities
- 3. CAO Sonya Pritchard offered insight as to the process, whereby the subcommittee can take recommendations to the bigger committee; committee takes said recommendations to Council
- 4. To Trisha's initial question, the subcommittee discussed opportunities, such as:
 - Where can we enhance, promote, or make recommendations to enhance the diversity and inclusion of the region?
 - The need for a plan for Dufferin County, and how we can: diversify businesses as well as people spending money in the County; keeps businesses in the County; infuse diversity through strategic planning
 - The need for an educational approach, and giving businesses the right tools to be equitable and inclusive in their practices

- The need to evaluate who is participating in Economic Development & Tourism initiatives (i.e, Agricultural Roundtables), and the opportunity for the committee to recognize opportunities for intersections
- The need to consider inclusive branding, visual considerations
- The need to consider and adapt to how people engage with certain businesses versus others, based on the resources and networks available
- The need to address accessibility challenges to local businesses, such as office hours of SBEC
- 5. Phil DeWar and Jim Waddington discussed the Diversity Walk Orangeville, and potential opportunity for County to provide support or participate
- 6. The committee discussed a video, as proposed by Councillor Anderson, to introduce the Committee to the community
 - Proposed there be other elements (print, radio?) to support this initiative for accessibility considerations

Discussion

- 1. Discussed details of committee meeting on April 14, 2021
- 2. Increased police powers
 - Province implemented increased capacity for police services due to provincial lockdown measures and then revoked
- 3. Human trafficking and sex workers in the community
 - Recent issue in Orangeville neighbourhood which caused negative discussion on social media
 - Has created an undertone of racism and prejudice
 - There is a lack of empathy/understanding and/or mindfulness of their story
 - More education is needed for the community
 - Crynot is a local resource and is providing educational opportunities in regards to this

4. Social Media

- Tends to provide outlet for negative exchanges/posts which often contain derogatory comments about others
- Could an awareness campaign be developed to support appropriate behaviour and healthy discussion when using social media?

5. OPP vs. OPS

- Appears to be better morale among officers
- Switch has been successful thus far
- There has been a tremendous cost saving for the community
- Officers have new, updated equipment

- 6. Indicating DEI Endeavours on Entry Signs
 - Is it possible to attach something to the new signs erected upon entry to each municipality in Dufferin County indicating our dedication to DEI work?
- 7. Age Friendly Initiative
 - Sabina provided information gathered from Mark and Linda regarding GrandPals program based on prior subcommittee discussion regarding increased supports to seniors in the community
 - It was suggested that the committee apply for a grant through the Centre for Aging
 - A survey should be conducted to see what the needs of older adults in the community actually are – would need to be mindful of COVID restrictions to execute
 - May be possible for the DEICAC to work in conjunction with existing program
 - Sabina will reach out to Mark and Linda for links to survey examples and bring back to subcommittee
- 8. Communications Strategic Plan
 - Should be discussed with larger committee
 - Would like to meet with County of Dufferin's newly hired Manager of Communications, Timothy Chan, to discuss how the committee can establish and execute potential endeavours
 - Ideas include: education/awareness campaigns, videos, human library, etc.
