SUBJECT	Rescue Calls		
AUTHORITY	Motion 6, Roads and Environment Committee, Oct. 11, 1994		

PURPOSE:

To outline the policy and procedure on paying for and recovering the costs of rescue calls when local fire services are called to accident scenes on County Roads.

STATEMENT:

1. The County of Dufferin will reimburse a local municipality for the cost incurred by the local municipality for rescue calls performed by a fire department to attend at a vehicle accident scene or a vehicle fire on a County Road. Reimbursement will be based on current MTO rates.
2. An invoice from the local municipality with the attached information must be submitted to the County Road Department within 90 calendar days of the occurrence:
 - a rescue call or reference number
 - the date of the accident
 - the location of the accident scene
 - the names of all of the drivers involved in the accident
 - the names of all of the insured owners of all of the vehicles
 - the insurance company names and policy numbers for all of the vehicles
 - the cost of the call being charged to the County of Dufferin.
3. Provided the above information is submitted to the County, the County will pay the invoice of the local municipality on the next Road Department voucher.
