EMERGENCY CHILD CARE



The County of Dufferin is working in partnership with the YMCA, the Upper Grand District School Board and the Ministry of Education to support health care workers and other front line workers in Dufferin by providing access to licensed child care at no cost during the COVID-19 pandemic.

What's different about Emergency Child Care?

Enhanced Safety Measures:

- Daily screening for all children, staff and parents
- Lower staff to child ratios to ensure physical distancing
- Enhanced full time cleaning
- No visitors allowed in any site
- Isolation room if a child or staff falls ill during the day
- Support for children with additional needs
