

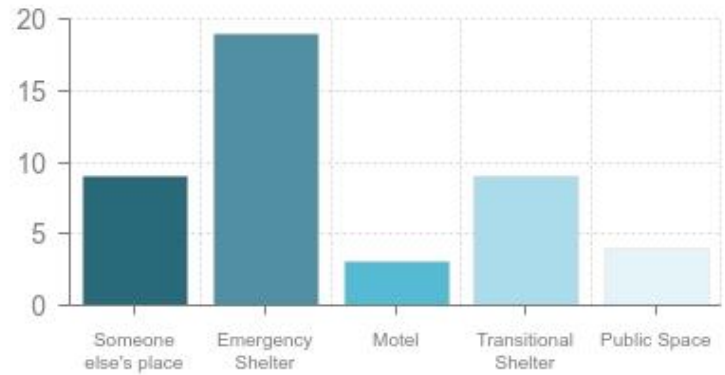
# HOMELESS COUNT RESULTS - 2018 POINT-IN-TIME COUNT

**44** INDIVIDUALS EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS IN DUFFERIN COUNTY

**45%** Have been homeless for 6 months or more

**61%** Have not had PERMANENT housing in at least 12 months
